Quick Installation Tip


External Corners should be installed first, starting from bottom and alternating long and short Legs/Returns. Flats can be installed to fill in areas with joins to be staggered. Select stones from several different boxes to ensure proper blend of colour variation. Layout pattern on ground first.

Cutting

Our manufactured veneers can be easily cut or trimmed using an electric tile cutter or hand held grinders with a diamond or masonry blade. Trimming can also be done by using a hatchet or wide-mouth nipper.
